



Inside this box you'll find everything you need to run the British Science Association's CREST Star Award with your children.

CREST resources are designed to be accessible and easy to use, and they are completely free to download from our website. However, we wanted to go a step further and provide maximum support for educators to run CREST Awards challenges, so it is our pleasure to present you with this fully funded CREST Star Kit Box!

### What is a CREST Star Award?

Designed for children aged 3-7, or those working at this level, Star Awards are a great introduction to problem solving in science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM). To gain a Star Award, children need to complete at least six one-hour activities.

These activities link to multiple areas of the curriculum, offering children the opportunity to learn through hands-on challenges. By exploring the world around them, children can develop their investigation, communication and teamwork skills.

### What is in the boxes?

We want you to be able to 'pick up and run' these activities with as little planning and preparation time as possible, so we have included all the equipment you will need to run:

- Animal Adventure
- Be Seen, Be Safe
- Peggy Problem
- Plant Detectives

- Sneaky Shadow
- Sniffly Sneezes
- Testing Timers
- Useless Umbrella

Please note, some of the resources will be used for more than one activity. Where possible, we have provided enough sets of equipment for you to run the challenges both with small groups or with a whole class. Two of the eight activities work best with small groups so, for these, we have supplied fewer sets of equipment that you can use multiple times.

## **Reusing your CREST Star Kit Box**

Your kit box is designed to be used more than once! All the physical equipment provided has been selected to be robust and reusable where possible, so you can run the challenges again with another group or pass the box on to colleagues.





### Where do I start?

- You'll find Activity and Organiser Cards in the box of printed resources. These cards provide all the instructions you need to run the activities, including introductory stories and scenarios to engage your children.
- There are also accompanying PowerPoint slides available to support your children's understanding of the challenges – these can be found on the CREST Star Kit Box webpage.
- After each challenge, children record their progress using the Star Passports and stickers provided.
- Once they have completed at least six activities you can recognise and reward them with the CREST certificates! Why not invite parents and carers to a special assembly so they can be part of the celebration?
